Details:

On the above listed date and time, units responded to the area of Mooney and Orchard regarding an injury traffic collision. Upon arrival, it was discovered that a 2002 white Chrysler sedan being driven by Gloria Semoes was southbound Mooney Blvd. just north of Orchard when it struck a male and female pedestrian that were both crossing Mooney Blvd. in a westerly direction just North of Orchard. The male pedestrian (Dockins) sustained moderate injuries and was treated/released from Kaweah Delta Medical Center. The female pedestrian (Lamb) sustained serious injuries and was transferred to Community Regional Medical Center in Fresno where she remains in critical condition. The driver of the white Chrysler sedan (Semoes) was not injured. The cause of the collision is under investigation and being handled by the Visalia Police Department Traffic Unit.
