**Details:** On the listed date and time, Visalia Police Department officers responded to Rancho Fiesta Mobile Estates for a report of shots fired. Upon arrival, officers learned a male had stopped his vehicle at a residence to pick up a passenger when a male exited the same residence and a verbal altercation ensued between the two. The male resident broke a window to the victim's vehicle. The victim then began to drive away from the residence when the suspect fired one round from a handgun striking the vehicle. No one was injured. Suspect Christopher Cantrell was arrested at the scene and booked into jail for assault with a deadly weapon.
