Details: On 1031/17 at approx. 0205 hours officers with the Visalia Police Department responded to the Green Olive Bar, located at 1415 E. Mineral King in Visalia, for a disturbance in which an intoxicated male was refusing to leave. Upon arrival the officer located and detained that subject. In speaking with other parties on scene officers learned that after being removed from the bar the subject, identified as S/Gallardo-Olguin, had removed a handgun from his vehicle and fired one round into the air. Officers were able to locate the firearm. S/Gallardo-Olguin was also found to be in possession of a small amount of narcotics. He was transported and booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-trail Facility for charges of negligently discharging a firearm, and narcotics possession.
