Details: On 10/28/17 at approximately 1145 hours, officers responded to Dimples Diner for a report of a theft and shots fired. Officers learned two suspects entered the business taking multiple fundraising containers from the counter. The suspects then fled to a nearby vehicle while being chased by patrons of the business. As the suspects drove away a handgun was discharged multiple times in the direction of the patrons. The vehicle was located a short time later with the assistance of the Tulare County Sheriff's Office. No injuries were reported. The investigation is on-going. *****UPDATE****

The VPD Violent Crimes Unit was assigned the investigation and was able to identify Eric Henley-Meza as the shooter. On 12/08/17 at 0950 hours, VPD's Special Enforcement Unit arrested Henley-Mesa without incident at a residence in the 1100 blk N. Stover, Visalia. Henley-Mesa was booked at the Tulare County Jail for several counts of Assault with a Deadly Weapon (Firearm) and other charges. The investigation is on-going.
