Details: On January 20, 2018, between the hours of 6 p.m. and 12 a.m., Visalia Police Officers and ABC conducted a minor decoy operation. During the six hour detail, an underage decoy was sent into thirteen ABC licensed establishments and attempted to purchase alcoholic beverages. The underage decoy was able to purchase alcohol at four of the thirteen locations visited. Jack & Charlies, The 5th Quarter, Rookies Sportsbar and Grill, and The Phd all sold alcholic beverages to the underage decoy and will face an administrative review by ABC, the business could face a fine or a suspension of their alcohol license. The Visalia Police Department urges all licensed establishments to check the ID's of all inviduals who appear to be younger than 30 years of age.
