

SPECIAL EVENTS GUIDE

The purpose of this document is to provide clarification between the different types of special events, provide a guide on how applications are processed and timelines differentiate between events types. For more detailed information on items addressed in this document or subjects not addressed, please see Visalia Municipal Code 12.48.

Special Event (Non-Expressive) <u>Type A</u> -Events <u>NOT</u> likely to be, in, upon, or along any portions of any city street, sidewalk, alley, or other public right-of-way; or not have, nor plan to have more than one thousand (1,000) persons in attendance.

Definition: An event that is <u>not classified</u> as an "Expressive Event" or a "Spontaneous Expressive Event" conducted solely or primarily for the purpose of engaging in speech protected by the First Amendment of the United States Constitution or Article 1, Section 2 of the California Constitution.

Special Event (Non-Expressive) <u>Type B</u> - Events likely to be, in, upon, or along any portions of any city street, sidewalk, alley, or other public right-of-way; or have, plan to have more than one thousand (1,000) persons in attendance.

Definition: An event that is <u>not classified</u> as an "Expressive Event" or a "Spontaneous Expressive Event" conducted solely or primarily for the purpose of engaging in speech protected by the First Amendment of the United States Constitution or Article 1, Section 2 of the California Constitution.

Definition: "Spontaneous Expressive Events" shall mean any Expressive Event occasioned by news, affairs, or circumstances coming into public knowledge less than five (5) days prior to the date of such event.

Special Event (Non-Expressive) Type A

Events <u>NOT</u> likely to be, in, upon, or along any portions of any city street, sidewalk, alley, or other public right-of-way; or not have, nor plan to have more than one thousand (1,000) persons in attendance.

Spontaneous Expressive Event

Definition:	"Spontaneous Expressive Events" shall mean any Expressive Event occasioned by news, affairs, or circumstances	
Spontaneous Expressive Event	coming into public knowledge less than five (5) days prior to the date of such event.	

Prior to the start of the event, the organizer of a Spontaneous Expressive Event shall notify the Special Events Committee
of the event and, to the extent reasonably practicable under the circumstances, respond to all appropriate requests for
information.

VMC 12.48.070 (B)

 A Spontaneous Expressive Event must not present a substantial safety or traffic hazard and must not unduly impede, obstruct, impair, or interfere with the public's use of the street or other public property, the operation of emergency vehicles, the provision of city services, or any lawful competing use of the location where the event is located. VMC 12.48.070 (C)

If any portion the previous prevision cannot be met than the following shall apply:

VMC 12.48.070 (D)

O Unless the Spontaneous Expressive Event's location has special communicative value to the purpose of the event and such value would be lost by moving the event to another location, the event's organizer must make a diligent and good faith effort to relocate the event, and its participants, to another location that does not present a substantial safety or traffic hazard, or unduly impede, obstruct, impair, or interfere with the public's use of the street or other public property, the operation of emergency vehicles, the provision of city services, or any lawful competing use of the location where the event is located.

o If the Spontaneous Expressive Event cannot be relocated due to the special communicative value of the event's location or the unavailability of another location, then the Chief of Police shall take appropriate action to the extent reasonably necessary to eliminate the hazard, risk, interference, or impairment; provided, however, that the Chief of Police shall not order the area cleared or the cessation of spontaneous expressive activities unless reasonably necessary to avoid imminent danger to person or property.
