Details: On April 12, 2018 at approximately 11:47 PM, officers were dispatched to The Green Olive in regards to a subject that was brandishing a firearm and causing a disturbance at the business. Upon arrival, officers from Patrol and the Special Enforcement Unit attempted to make contact with the suspect; however, he fled from the area on foot.
