Details: On 7-16-19 at 0149 hrs. a Visalia Police Department K-9 officer was patrolling the area of NW 3rd and Strawberry when he hears an audible burglar alarm sounding in the area. He responds to the Salvation Army and observes (S) Rheanna Madrid exiting the building through a broken window. He further observes (S) Alex Salinas acting as a look-out. With the assistance of his K-9 partner, the officer is able to detain the suspects until assisting officers arrive on-scene and take them into custody without incident. Officers located a laundry basket full of items that the suspects had removed from the store. The items were returned to the store manager. Both suspects were booked at the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility for the listed charges. There were no injuries to suspects or officers.
