Chief Jason Salazar Announces Lieutenant Promotions

Lieutenant Kevin Kroeze began his law enforcement career as a Community Service Officer for the city of Paramount in 1998. In October of 2017, Andrew promoted to Sergeant where he has been assigned to Patrol.
