**Details:** On December 5th, 2019 at approximately 0222 hours an officer with the Visalia Police Department observed a vehicle driving reckless in the area of Houston and Dinuba in the City of Visalia. The officer attempted to stop the vehicle, which failed to yield, and a vehicle pursuit was initiated. Following a short pursuit the suspect voluntarily stopped his vehicle in the area of Harold and Conyer where he was taken into custody without incident. In addition to the charges related to the vehicle pursuit the driver was also arrested for suspicion of driving under the influence. The suspect in this case is identified at 24 year old Aipa See, a Visalia resident. He was subsequently booked into the Tulare County Adult Pretrial Facility.
