**Details:** On 1-11-20 three females entered Ulta Beauty on south Mooney Blvd. in Visalia. The females selected over \$1,800 in merchandise and then exited the store without paying. Employees of Ulta contacted the subject and requested they return the products or pay for it. At that time suspect Vallejo pulled out a stun gun turned it on and threatened the Ulta employees. The employees stepped back and let the subjects flee in a vehicle. The Visalia Police Dept. Property Crimes Unit learned during the investigation that the city of Hanford had a similar robbery involving an Ulta store and a stun gun on 1-9-20. Working with Hanford PD we were able to confirm through video that (S) Vallejo was also one of the suspects in the Hanford robbery. On todays at approx. 1100 Am Visalia PD detectives took (s) Vallejo into custody in a McDonald's parking lot in the City of Fresno without incident. Some of the Ulta property was recovered.
