- Maintain and enhance economic vibrancy











Project Area: Santa Fe to Ben Maddox



Work Completed to Date

- Data Collection and Analysis:
 - Traffic volume and projected traffic conditions
 - 4 Scenarios: Existing, Existing w/ Project, Future (2024), Future w/ Project
 - Collision history
 - Existing pedestrian and bicycle infrastructure
 - Existing bus routes and bus stop amenities
 - Design concepts

Traffic Conditions (Today and 2024)

Existing, Existing with Project, and 2024 Conditions

- Intersection LOS: acceptable
- Queue: adequate queue lengths for all intersection movements

2024 with Project Conditions


- Intersection LOS: acceptable
- Queue: insufficient queue lengths @
 - Main St/Ben Maddox Way for the EBL, WBL, NBR, and SBL
 - Center Ave/Ben Maddox Way for the NBL




Type of Collision




Primary Collision Factor: Violation Category




Pedestrian Collisions



Pedestrian & Bicycle Infrastructure




Bus Routes and Stops





One-Way Conversion Alternatives

Proposed Circulation (for both alternatives)





Alternatives

1. Diagonal Parking & Shared Bikeways



2. Parallel Parking & Class II Bike Lanes



Alternatives: Pros & Cons

1. Diagonal Parking & Shared Bikeways

Pros

- Extended Downtown feel
- Vehicular-friendly configuration

Cons

- Losing 10 parking spaces
- Unsafe for bicyclists
- Only shared bikeway can be accommodated; not a dedicated bike lane
- Impact line of sight due to angled parking
- Wide travel lanes

2. Parallel Parking & Class II Bike Lanes

Pros

- Safer bicycle paths
- More marked crosswalks accommodated
- Bulb-outs that shorten crossing distances

Cons

- Losing 7 parking spaces
- Higher maintenance cost for the more striping
- Some crossings are uncontrolled
- · Lane shift at signalized intersections
