**Details:** On May 1st, 2020 at approximately 2352 hours the Visalia Police Department responded to a report of an assault with a deadly weapon just occurred at 7 Eleven located at 111 W. Walnut Ave in the City of Visalia. The investigation revealed that the suspect, Daniel Correa (38) of Visalia, entered the business and started a disturbance. As employees were attempting to get him to leave the property the suspect retrieved a screwdriver from his person and threatened the employee. The victim employee armed himself with a bat as the suspect advanced on him and was able to repel the suspects attack. The suspect was taken into custody by responding officers and booked into the Tulare County Adult Pretrial Facility for assault with a deadly weapon.
