Details: On September 27th, 2020 at approximately 0320 hours an officer with the Visalia Police Department attempted to conduct an enforcement stop on a reckless vehicle in the area of Ben Maddox and Ferguson and the vehicle failed to yield. At this point a vehicle pursuit was initiated. After a short time a unit was able to successfully deploy spike strips. The Vehicle continued for a distance when the driver voluntarily stopped, and the passenger fled on foot. The passenger was identified as Angel Burciaga (19) of Dinuba. Burciaga was apprehended following a foot pursuit and ultimately booked for resisting arrest and possession of narcotics for sales. The driver was identified as Alexis Enriquez (26) of Dinuba and ultimately booked for transportation of narcotics for sales and felony evading.
