**Details:** On 11-28-2020, at 1137 hrs, officers responded to the 2700 blk of W. Tyler regarding a suspicious circumstance. An unknown male had attempted to gain entry to a residence, and was looking into windows in the backyard. The male fled prior to police arrival. The suspect, Dominic Guyton, was observed jumping fences, and located in a nearby neighborhood where he was taken into custody. He was positively identified by the victim. The suspect was transported and booked in the Tulare County Pretrial facility for charges of Attempted Residential Burglary, Resisting Arrest, and Trespassing.
