Details: On 09/05/2021 at approximately 6:00 a.m., officers with the Visalia Police Department were dispatched to Sensations Boutique located in the 1200 Blk of E. Houston regarding a burglary in progress. The information was two males were taking merchandise from the business and loading it into a vehicle. Upon arrival, officers located the two males and the vehicle. Both subjects were immediately detained and subsequently taken into custody. A large amount of stolen property estimated to be worth approximately \$8,000.00 was recovered from the vehicle and returned to the business owners. Both suspects were booked into the Tulare County Sheriff's Department Pre-Trial facility on various charges including burglary.
