Background:

On January 7, 2008, the City Council reviewed an item by Administrative Services Director Eric Frost on the City's Annual Impact Fee report which is required by law. As part of the discussion, the Council was provided an overview of the City's sixyear Capital Improvement Projects (CIP) program.

At that meeting, the Council suggested a joint session with the Parks & Recreation Commission to review the status of the CIP program.

City staff will provide an overview on the current Parks & Recreation CIP program for Fiscal Years 2006-08. As part of the upcoming budget process, Administrative Services Director Eric Frost will be providing the City Council with information outlining the proposed Parks & Recreation six-year CIP program for Fiscal years 2008-14.

For some projects, a number of funds are used to finance parks and recreation projects. Many times these projects are "multi-funded" meaning the projects show up on multiple spreadsheets. Funds for park projects will come from the General Fund (0014); Developer Impact Fee Funds (1211); Measure R Bike & Trail Fund (1132); and the Waterways Fund (1251).
