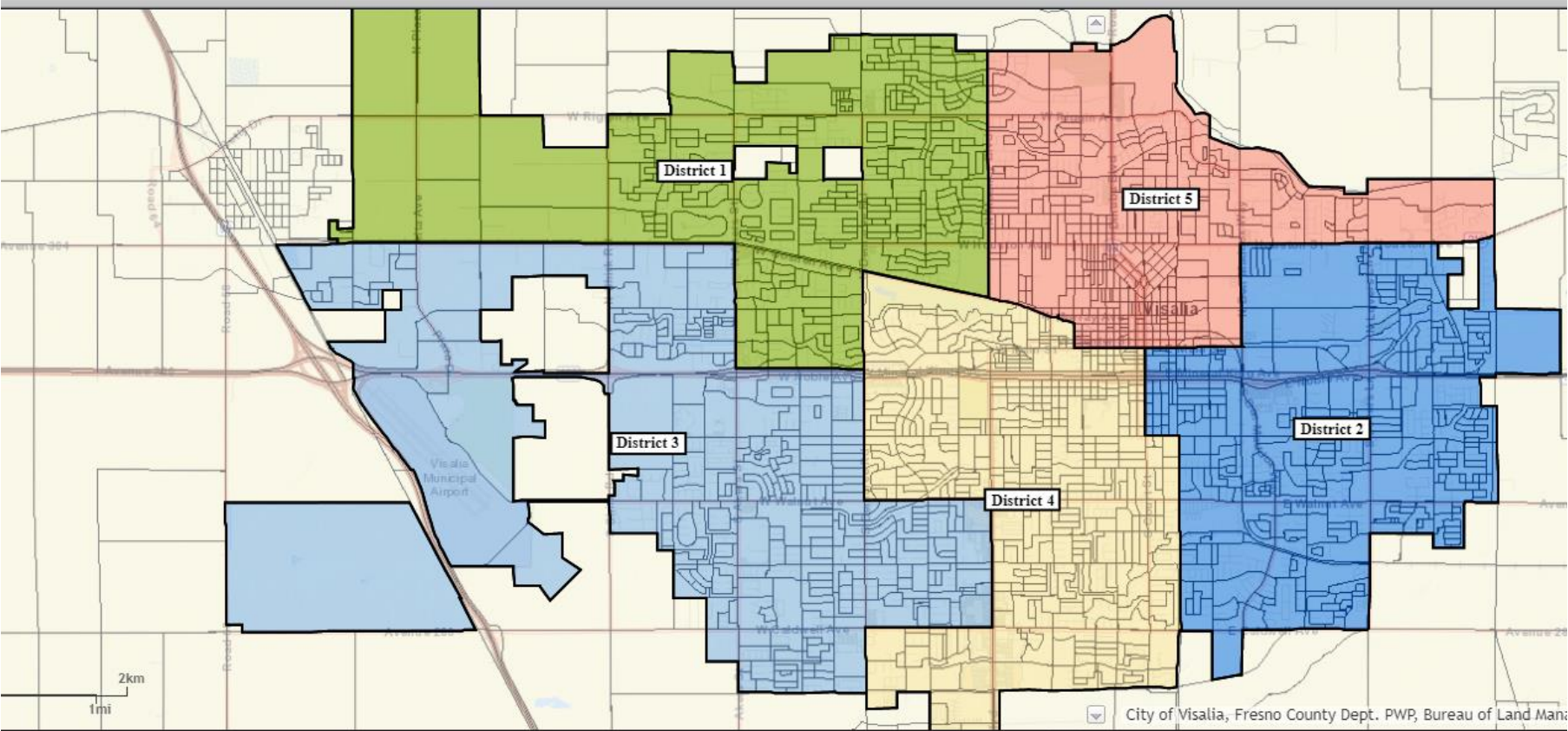

Goals of Map:

Share Downtown and Main Street Between 2 – 4 Districts

Split Industrial Park between 2 Districts

Share Mooney (South) Between 2 or 3 districts

1 District bordering St Johns River (if practical).

Evenly Divide Population Average of ~28,400 people +/- 5% = Range of 27,000 – 29,800

Highlights of Map:

Main Street:

District 5 goes from Main Street to the North (NoDo – North of Downtown)

District 2 has South Side of Main Street East of Court Street

District 4 has South Side of Main West of Court and all of Main Street west of Jacob. St.

Industrial Park:

Split at Goshen Ave. District 1 North of Goshen and District 3 is South of Goshen (includes Airport)

South Mooney Blvd.:

Mostly in District 4.

District 3 goes to Mooney between Walnut and Caldwell.

St Johns River:

District 5 has all of the St Johns River that touches the City boundary.

Population:

High Population of 29,262 for District 5 (2.34% above average)

Low Population of 27,741 for District 4 (3.01% below average)

Population Range % is 5.35%
