Details: On 6/17/2022 at approximately 0421 hours Visalia Police Department responded to the 2100 block of N. Court for the report of shots fired inside of a residence. Once officers arrived on scene occupants began to exit the residence in compliance with officer's commands. Once the residence was secure the Violent Crimes Unit responded and took over the investigation. During the investigation, it was learned that Steven Palomino, 50, was firing a gun inside his residence. Family members were inside the residence at the time; however, no one was injured during the incident. Palomino was booked at the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility for Negligent Discharge of a Firearm.
