Make safe outdoor cooking a priority

Move the grill away from siding, decking, and other things that can catch fire.

Keep children and pets at least three feet away from the grill when it's hot.

Stay with the grill the entire time you're cooking. Keep your grill clean so leftover grease and fat won't catch on fire.
