

THE CITY AND POLICE DEPARTMENT

Visalia is a full service city that employs 650 full-time employees and approximately 200 hourly employees with a total 2021/2022 budget of \$234 million. The City's financial health is positive and Visalia has enjoyed a strong financial history. Visalia has also been effective with community planning, which has led to an active, vibrant and heavily visited downtown, a strong retail/commercial corridor and a thriving industrial area. The City has recently completed a new EOC/dispatch center, animal care facility, fire station, and a \$140 million upgrade to its Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The Visalia Police Department has served the citizens of Visalia since 1923 and has a long history of outstanding law enforcement service and strong community relations. The Visalia Police Department is a full-service law enforcement agency serving the public safety needs of the City of Visalia and its approximately 141,000 residents and more than 37 square miles. The Visalia Police Department employs 264 full-time employees, including 167 sworn officer positions and is comprised of three divisions, Operations, Operations Support, and Administration.

The Operations Division consists of the Patrol and Special Enforcement Bureaus that provide patrol, traffic, commercial, gang, and narcotics enforcement for the Department. In 2021, the Department fielded more than 135,000 police calls for service. The Patrol Bureau operates out of two District Substations, one in each policing district.

The Operations Support Division consists of the Investigations Bureau and Communications. This division operates out of Police Headquarters and the newly constructed Visalia Emergency Communications Center.

The Administrative Division consists of Records and the Professional Standards Bureau which oversees hiring, policy, and training. In 2019, the Department was recognized with the California POST Excellence In Training Award for its ongoing efforts to provide Crisis Intervention Training (CIT) in partnership with Mental Health to local law enforcement agencies.

The Visalia Police Department works to embrace new technologies, implement proactive policing strategies to address crime and quality of life issues in Visalia, and strives to create partnerships with our community that are essential to public safety. We are honored to serve our community through professional police services and by building positive police-community relationships.




THE POSITION/IDEAL CANDIDATE

The Visalia Police Department is seeking a proven law enforcement manager with graduation from a four-year college or university with major coursework in criminal justice, police science, public administration or related field, supervisory or management experience in police service, equivalent to the rank of Sergeant or above, POST Advanced Certificate, and possession of firearms qualification. Completion of advanced training such as the POST Supervisory Leadership Institute, POST Command College, or the Los Angeles Police Department Leadership Academy, and the POST Supervisory Certificate are highly desirable. Any combination equivalent to experience and education that could likely provide the required knowledge, skill and ability is qualifying.

The ideal candidate for Police Lieutenant will be an experienced, ethical, innovative, self-motivated, professional police supervisor/manager with strong interpersonal and leadership skills. They will possess the ability to perform complex administrative duties, oversee investigations, manage bureau operations and budget, and have strong administrative and personnel skills. Candidates will possess good listening and communication skills, work as a problem solver, demonstrate strong community involvement, and be supportive of new ideas. They will have demonstrated an excellent working relationship with their Police Chief or prior law enforcement executives and managers, department personnel, the community, and other governmental partners. The Police Lieutenant candidate must have worked collaboratively with others at all levels and be recognized as an individual who reflects the organizational values of the Visalia Police Department and the City of Visalia. They must be a person of high integrity and committed to making the community a great place to live, work, and play.

The ability to communicate effectively is a key element of this position. The successful candidate will attend City Council and other meetings to present reports, answer questions and make recommendations. They will be an effective problem solver who identifies goals, gathers information, considers the consequences, makes decisions, and evaluates their decisions. The ability to multitask, identify and overcome obstacles, be a team player and work cooperatively with the management team is essential.
