Details: On 8-15-2022 at approximately 4:05 a.m., Visalia Police Department officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of S. Bollinger regarding a disturbance at the location. While officers were investigating the incident it was determined that the suspect Conrad Madrid (51), had been involved in an altercation at the residence and had endangered the safety of a minor child in the process. Officers were unable to take (S) Madrid into custody at that time, but Violent Crimes Detectives continued to work the case. During this time, (S) Madrid continued to contact the victim, placing her in additional fear for her safety and detectives obtained an arrest warrant for (S) Madrid.

On 8-16-2022 at 10:13 a.m., officers with the Special Enforcement Bureau located (S) Madrid at the location and he fled from officers, ultimately barricading himself in a bedroom. (S) Madrid made threats to shoot officers on-scene and the Visalia Police Department SWAT Team was called out to assist. V.P.D. SWAT Team members successfully took (S) Madrid into custody without incident. There were no injuries to the suspect or officers as a result of this incident.

Conrad Madrid will be booked at the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility on multiple felony charges.
