Details: On 10/15/2022 at approximately 4:44 P.M., officers initiated a traffic stop on a black Cadillac at the intersection of Race Ave and Locust St. As officers approached the vehicle, the driver drove away at a high rate of speed. Officers did not pursue the vehicle.

At 4:47 P.M., Dispatch received a call regarding a Cadillac sedan that collided into a residence in the 200 block of W Grove. The residence struck was unoccupied at the time, and no one was injured. Officers conducted an area check and located the driver, Anthony Sandoval, near the intersection of Pershing Ave and Willis St. Sandoval was arrested without further incident.

Officers later learned that just prior to colliding into the residence, Sandoval was involved in a collision with another motorist. The driver of the vehicle involved was transported to Kaweah Health. Sandoval was booked at the Tulare County Pre-Trial Facility for Felony Reckless Evading, Felony Hit and Run, and Possession of a Controlled Substance.
