AGRICULTURAL PRESERVATION ORDINANCE

PUBLIC WORKSHOP ANNOUNCEMENT

The City of Visalia has initiated the development of an Agricultural Preservation Ordinance. The ordinance, once adopted, will require development that converts Prime Farmland and Farmland of Statewide Importance to preserve equivalent land in an agricultural conservation easement. A public workshop is being held for the project team to receive direction from the City Council.

WORKSHOP TOPICS

The City of Visalia adopted its General Plan in 2014, which plans development and growth in the City until 2030. The City is adopting an agricutlural preservation ordinance to implement policies identified in the General Plan. At the workshop, the project team will be seeking input from the City Council on key decision points regarding the direction of the ordinance. There will also be a period for public comment during the workshop.
