

Committee & Commission Vacancies July 10, 2025

The City of Visalia is accepting applications from interested citizens for the following Committees, Commissions, and Boards:

Parks & Recreation Commission – Advises the City Council and City staff in matters pertaining to parks, playgrounds and recreation centers. The Visalia City Council is currently accepting applications to fill one vacant commission seat.

Measure R Citizens Advisory Committee – Provides input on implementation of the 2006 ½ Cent Transportation Sales Tax Measure Expenditure Plan ("plan"), and to advise the TCAG Board if and when the plan needs to be augmented and to ensure that the funds are being spent in accordance with the plan.

Building Advisory Committee – The purpose of the Building Advisory Committee/Board of Appeals is to provide a forum for discussion of permit processing, building industry concerns, contractor practices and code interpretation as well as provide an appeals process for the public. The Committee is currently accepting applications for all commission seats.

Historic Preservation Committee – Administers and carries out the standards and specifications of the Historic Preservation Ordinance. Promotes historic preservation including encouraging building owners to initiate preservation efforts. The Committee facilitates building identification and seeks to preserve Visalia's historic structures. The Visalia City Council is currently accepting applications to fill one vacant committee seat.

Planning Commission – Makes recommendations to the City Council concerning land use, building and subdivisions, administers the Zoning Ordinance and handles matters that affect the growth and development of Visalia. The Visalia City Council is current accepting applications to fill one commission seat.
