Wanted Attempted Murder Suspect Arrested in Visalia Traffic Stop

Just after 8:00 p.m., Visalia Police Department officers conducted a traffic stop on a vehicle near Mooney Boulevard and Cameron Avenue.

The vehicle was flagged as wanted in connection to an attempted murder investigation—specifically, a violation of Penal Code 664/187 PC, which refers to attempted murder—out of Corcoran. The firearm involved in the case was still outstanding at the time.

Officers detained the occupants of the vehicle. The driver was found to have an active warrant for 664/187 PC and was turned over to Corcoran Police Department.

During a search of the vehicle, officers discovered a loaded, unregistered firearm inside the female passenger's purse. She was arrested and booked at the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Detention Facility.
