Visalia Police Seek Public's Help in Fatal Hit-and-Run Investigation

The Visalia Police Department Traffic Unit is asking for the public's assistance in identifying a driver involved in a fatal hit-and-run accident.

On Saturday, May 3, 2025, at approximately 9:45 p.m., officers responded to a collision on southbound Akers Street, just south of Judy Avenue. A vehicle struck a 53-year-old male bicyclist and then fled the scene before officers arrived.

The bicyclist was transported to Kaweah Health with serious injuries and tragically passed away from his injuries the following morning.

The suspect vehicle involved is described as a 2018-2020 white Ford F-150.
