DOJ Grant Helps VPD Officers Crack Down on Tobacco Sales to Minors

On May 20 and May 22, 2025, officers from the Visalia Police Department carried out tobacco minor decoy operations to determine whether local businesses were complying with laws prohibiting the sale of tobacco products to minors. Under police supervision, underage decoys were sent into various businesses throughout the City of Visalia to attempt to purchase tobacco products. As a result of the operation, two businesses were cited for illegally selling tobacco to a minor.

The Visalia Police Department, in partnership with the California State Department of Justice, is committed to protecting children by preventing tobacco and nicotine addiction. Smoking remains the leading cause of preventable death, killing over 480 thousand people in the United States annually. Nearly nine in ten daily smokers start smoking before the age of 18.

In an effort to combat underage smoking, the Visalia Police Department will be holding a series of tobacco decoy and compliance inspections throughout the year to ensure businesses are complying with state law. A retailer who is found guilty can be charged for a misdemeanor or subject to a fine up to \$1,000.
