UPDATE: Arrest Made in Fatal Hit-and-Run Investigation

On June 11, 2025, at approximately 4:00 a.m., Visalia Police Department officers were dispatched to the intersection of Noble Avenue and Vista Street after receiving a report of a man lying in the roadway. Officers arrived and discovered the man unresponsive. He was transported to Kaweah Health, where he tragically passed away. The Visalia PD Traffic Unit responded and took over the investigation.

Through video surveillance and witness statements, officers determined the incident was a hit-and-run. Investigators were able to identify the suspect as 43-year-old Dail Hover.

Yesterday, members of the VPD Traffic Unit and the Special Enforcement Unit (SEU) arrested Hover at a residence in the 1200 block of West Wren. He was taken into custody and booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Detention Facility on charges of vehicular manslaughter and felony hit and run.
