HAPPENING OVERNIGHT: Traffic Stop Leads to Drug Arrest of Rocklin Man in Tulare County

Just before midnight, at approximately 11:38 p.m., a Visalia police officer attempted to stop a vehicle near Mineral King Avenue and Lovers Lane. The driver failed to yield and continued driving into Tulare County before eventually stopping on State Route 216, east of Comstock.

The driver, identified as 31-year-old Clint Remien of Rocklin, California, was taken into custody. During the search of his vehicle, officers discovered two pounds of marijuana, a digital scale, and several plastic baggies. They also located a hidden compartment that contained 23 grams of suspected cocaine.

Remien was arrested on multiple felony charges, including evading a peace officer, driving without a license, possession of a controlled substance for sale, and possession of marijuana for sale. He also had an outstanding warrant from Fresno County for carrying a loaded firearm in public. He was booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Facility.
