Two Students Arrested After Fight at Redwood High School

At approximately 10:15 a.m., a Youth Services Officer at Redwood High School was notified of a fight on campus. The officer, who was already on site, quickly intervened. A knife was involved in the incident, but thankfully, no one was seriously injured. Both students were taken into custody without further incident.

Youth Services Officers are actively investigating, and we want to assure everyone that the campus is safe for students and staff. As always, we remind our community: If you see something, say something.

Please see the message below shared by VUSD regarding this incident.

"Dear Redwood [Families/Staff],

This morning, during our 1st and 2nd passing period, two students engaged in a fight in the restroom where a small knife was involved. School administrative staff and the campus Youth Services Officer intervened, and the students were taken into custody. One student sustained non-critical injuries and received medical attention on campus before being transported by ambulance. We will continue to work closely with the Visalia Police Department to investigate the incident and ensure appropriate consequences are administered.

The safety of our students and staff is our top priority. We continue to encourage our community to say something, if they see something. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact me directly.
