Two 20-Year-Olds Arrested in Connection with Downtown Visalia Fatal Shooting

On Saturday, September 6, 2025, approximately 1:43 a.m., Visalia Police Department officers responded to reports of a shooting at Sebby's, located near Main Street and Garden Street. When officers arrived, they found multiple people had been shot following a fight that broke out inside the establishment. Three individuals were transported to Kaweah Health for their injuries. Sadly, one of the victims, a 22-year-old male, died from their injuries. The Visalia Police Department's Violent Crimes Unit took over the investigation.

After an extensive, all-day investigation, detectives from the Violent Crimes Unit, along with the Special Enforcement Unit (SEU), arrested two suspects in connection with the fatal shooting. 20-year-old Eduardo Moreno Torres was booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Facility for attempted murder. 20-year-old Raymon Vasquez has been charged with murder and will be booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Facility once he is medically cleared.

We want to reassure our community that this was an isolated incident, and the suspects are in custody. We are very proud of our detectives for their hard work in solving this murder investigation in less than 24 hours. Your safety is always our top priority, and we are committed to protecting Visalia every day.
