Visalia PD Traffic Stop Leads to Arrest on Multiple Warrants

Just before 11:00 a.m. yesterday, Visalia PD detectives conducted a traffic stop on a U-Haul on Murray Avenue, just west of Jacob Street, for an illegal U-turn. The 36-year-old driver, David Ramos, became uncooperative, rolling up his window and reaching near his waist. Concerned the driver could be reaching for a weapon, a detective used a glass breaker to access the vehicle. Ramos was taken into custody without further incident.

No weapons were found, but he had several active warrants, including a domestic violence hold, multiple felony warrants for weapons violations, vehicle theft, and a PRCS violation, as well as a misdemeanor warrant for driving without a license.

He was booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Facility for resisting arrest, his active warrants, and the domestic violence hold.
