Visalia Police Arrest 19-Year-Old Suspect Connected to Series of Armed Robberies and Burglaries

Since October 25, 2025, the Visalia Police Department Violent Crimes Unit began investigating several armed robberies believed to be committed by the same person. During the investigation, Detectives determined the same person was also involved in three residential burglaries. On November 3, 2025, a report of a person brandishing a firearm was reported and he matched the description of the individual involved in the robberies and burglaries. Through follow-up investigation, Detectives identified 19-year-old Andres Trejo of Visalia as being the person responsible for all these crimes.

On November 5, 2025, the Visalia Police Department Violent Crimes Unit with the assistance of the Special Enforcement Bureau and the HOPE Team, contacted and arrested Andres Trejo. A search warrant was served at his residence where items of evidence linking him to the crimes was located. Andres Trejo was booked at the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Facility for robbery, burglary, brandishing a weapon, stolen vehicle, possession of stolen property, as well as various firearm related charges.

The dates and locations of occurrence of these crimes are listed below:

October 25, 2025- Robbery at a business in the 4400 block of West Noble

October 27, 2025- Robbery at a business in the 2400 block of West Whitendale

October 30, 2025- Robbery at a business in the 2400 block of West Whitendale

October 31, 2025- Burglary in the 3500 Block of West La Vida

October 31, 2025- Burglary in the 1600 Block of West Main Street

October 31, 2025- Burglary and stolen vehicle taken from the 100 Block of South Central

November 3, 2025- Brandishing a firearm in the 100 Block of South Central

November 3, 2025- Robbery at a business in the 2400 block of West Whitendale
