Traffic Stop Leads to Arrest and Seizure of Loaded Firearms

Just after 1:45 p.m., a Visalia Police Department officer conducted a traffic stop on Leslie Street, north of Goshen Avenue, for a window tint violation. The driver, Allen Panyavong, repeatedly refused commands to exit the vehicle. He eventually complied and was taken into custody for resisting a police officer (148 PC).

The vehicle was towed, and an inventory search revealed a loaded Sig P365, a loaded Glock 26, and a 31-round Glock magazine inside the glove box.

Panyavong was booked into the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Facility on charges of carrying a concealed firearm (25400(a) PC), carrying a loaded firearm (25850(a) PC), possession of a large-capacity magazine (32310(c) PC), and resisting an officer (148 PC).
