HAPPENING OVERNIGHT: Pedestrian in Critical Condition After Being Struck on Walnut Avenue

At approximately 11:40 p.m. last night, Visalia Police Department officers responded to a vehicle-versus-pedestrian collision on eastbound Walnut Avenue, just west of Mooney Boulevard. Officers arrived and located a pedestrian who had been struck by a vehicle.

The victim was transported to Kaweah Health and is currently in critical condition.

Through the investigation, it was determined the pedestrian was crossing southbound across Walnut Avenue when they were struck by a vehicle traveling eastbound. The pedestrian was not within a marked crosswalk and was wearing dark clothing at the time of the collision. The driver remained at the scene and is cooperating with the investigation.
