Traffic Stop and Search Warrant Lead to Firearm Arrests in Visalia

At approximately 10:30 a.m. today, the Visalia Narcotics Unit, with assistance from the Visalia PD HOPE Team, served a search warrant at a residence in the 3800 block of East Oak Avenue. Before the warrant was served, 37-year-old Zachariah Viscarra was contacted and detained during a traffic stop.

During the search of the residence, officers located a dual-caliber Taurus Judge revolver inside Viscarra's bedroom. A separate Colt revolver was found in the bedroom of a 16-year-old juvenile.

Viscarra was arrested and booked at the Tulare County Adult Pre-Trial Detention Facility on multiple firearm-related charges, as well as child endangerment. The 16-year-old was taken into custody with assistance from YSO officers and booked at the Tulare County Juvenile Detention Facility on firearm-related charges.
